Important additional information

The parties have provided the Claims Administrator with a list of investors which includes the amounts the Settling Defendants believe each Class Member invested. If a claim is made by a Settlement Class Member who does not appear on the list of investors provided to the Claims Administrator by the Parties, or where the claim is made for an amount greater than that appearing on the investor list in respect of that person, the Claims Administrator will contact the Settlement Class Member and ask for further supporting documentation.

The Claims Administrator cannot accept Claim Forms postmarked after the Claims Deadline which is **JUNE 28, 2010**. If the Claims Administrator finds that technical deficiencies exist in a claim filed before the Claims Deadline, the Claims Administrator shall notify the Class Member by regular mail of the deficiency and the Class Member will have 30 days from the mailing of the notice to correct the deficiency.

The Claims Administrator will notify via regular mail all claiming Settlement Class Members as to the approval or rejection of their claims and the determination of the investment (the "**Decision Notice**").

Settlement Class Members will have thirty (30) days from the date the Decision Notice is sent to them to appeal the rejection (in whole or in part) of their claims. Such appeals will be on the basis of written submissions, supported only by the documentation provided to the Claims Administrator by the Claims Deadline.
